# Summary of February 26, 2024, FLC Monday Morning Call-In

# Charles Chapman Update:

- <u>HB 1195</u> (Garrison) and <u>SB 1322</u> (Ingoglia) Millage Rates/Supermajority Vote Oppose HB 1195 is on the February 27 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House. SB 1322 passed out of two committees but has one more committee stop, the Senate Appropriations Committee. SB 1322 is *not* on this week's Senate Appropriations Committee agenda.
- <u>HB 609</u> (Botana) and <u>SB 1144</u> (DiCeglie) Local Business Taxes Oppose HB 609 has passed all its committees and is now eligible to be considered by the full House. SB 1144 has not been heard in any committee.
- <u>HJR 7017</u> (Buchanan) Annual Adjustment to Homestead Exemption Value Oppose HJR 7017 passed the full House on February 1 and passed (9-5) out of the Senate Appropriations Committee on February 22. HJR 7017 is now on 2nd Reading in the Senate for consideration by the full Senate.

### David Cruz Update:

 <u>HB 479</u> (W. Robinson) and <u>SB 688</u> (Martin) Alternative Mobility Funding Systems – Support – HB 479 is on the February 27 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House. SB 688 will be heard in the Senate Rules Committee today, February 26, at 2:00 p.m. This is the final committee stop for SB 688.

 <u>SB 472</u> (Brodeur) and <u>HB 569</u> (McFarland) Suits Against the Government/Sovereign Immunity – Oppose –SB 472 will be heard today, February 26, at 2:00 p.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the last committee stop in the Senate. On February 14, HB 569 was temporarily postponed in its final committee, the House Judiciary Committee. The Judiciary Committee is not scheduled to meet.

### Jeff Branch Update:

- <u>SB 684</u> (DiCeglie) and <u>HB 267</u> (Esposito) Residential Building Permits Oppose SB 684 will be heard today, February 26, at 2:00 p.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. HB 267 passed all committees of reference and is now on 2nd Reading in the House.
- <u>HB 1239</u> (V. Lopez) and <u>SB 328</u> (Calatayud) Affordable Housing/Live Local Monitor Both HB 1239 and SB 328 are on the February 27 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House.

### Rebecca O'Hara Update:

 <u>SB 770</u> (Martin) and <u>HB 972</u> (Trabulsy) Improvements to Real Property/PACE – Support – Both SB 770 and HB 972 are on the February 27 House Special Order Calendar for consideration by the full House.

- <u>SB 1628</u> (Collins) and <u>HB 1547</u> (McClure) Local Government Actions Neutral on SB 1628, Oppose HB 1547– SB 1628 passed all its committees and is now on 2nd Reading in the Senate. HB 1547 passed all its committees and is now on 2nd Reading in the House.
- <u>SB 734</u> (Ingoglia) and <u>HB 735</u> (Andrade) Government Accountability Monitor HB 735 passed all its committees and is now on 2nd Reading in the House. SB 734 has one more committee stop, the Senate Appropriations Committee. SB 734 is *not* on this week's Senate Appropriations Committee agenda.

# Sam Wagoner Update:

- <u>HB 473</u> (Giallombardo) and <u>SB 658</u> (DiCeglie) **Cybersecurity Incident Liability Support –** Both bills passed all committees of reference and are on 2nd Reading.
- <u>HB 1365</u> (Garrison) and <u>SB 1530</u> (Martin) Unauthorized Public Camping and Public Sleeping Monitor – HB 1365 passed its last committee of reference last week, and the next stop is the House Floor. SB 1530 passed its final committee of reference last week and is now eligible for consideration by the full Senate.
- <u>HB 1537</u> (Griffitts) and <u>SB 280</u> (DiCeglie) Vacation Rentals Oppose SB 280 passed the full Senate and is House messages. HB 1537 passed its last committee of reference last week and the next stop is the House Floor. We do not yet know what day the bill will be on the House Special Order Calendar.
